ENROLLMENT

Many of the courses have online enrollment - please see course descriptions for online enrollment information. **ASEP providers which have printable registration forms can be found on the Glenview school website on the ASEP page under 'Parents Corner'.** Please download, print and complete those registration form(s) for each class in which you would like your child(ren) enrolled. There are also a limited number of printed ASEP flyers available in the school office. Make any checks payable to the instructor or provider as listed on the flyer. Send any forms, along with payment, DIRECTLY to the provider.

ONLY scholarship applicants should submit registration forms & any payment to the PTA Mailbox in the main office. Please see the *Scholarship Information and Scholarship Application* in this packet.

PARENT GUIDELINES



- ▶ Please make sure your child knows the time and place of his/her enrichment class. It is important that students be on their best behavior and are instructed to go directly to the class after school. STUDENTS MAY NOT WAIT IN THE OFFICE for classes to begin or for parent/guardian pick up. Children with behavior problems to, from and during class may not be allowed to continue attending these programs.
- ▶ The school requires that course providers escort TK and K students from their regular classroom to the ASEP location on the school campus. Parents/guardians will pickup their students at the assigned ASEP location after class.
- ▶ It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure that the student is either enrolled in Adventure Time/Learning Spot, or supervised by an adult while on school premises. There is no supervision provided after class dismissal. Please be on time to pick up your child!
- ▶ If your child is enrolled in a class that does not start immediately after dismissal (unless your child will be attending Adventure Time (AT) or Learning Spot (LS)), it is your responsibility to arrange for adult supervision for your child while he/she is waiting for his/her class to begin. Please do not sign your child up for an after-school program class unless you can arrange for regular and consistent adult supervision for your child while on campus. Neither the school nor the PTA is responsible for your children's whereabouts during these times.
- ▶ Please take note of "no-class dates". Classes do not meet on school holidays. There may be other times when a class does not meet for other reasons. Please read course descriptions and flyers carefully for information on specific classes, and contact the class instructor/provider directly with questions.
- ▶ If your student normally takes the bus, be sure they know their ASEP schedule, class location and to go directly to their ASEP class after school is dismissed. Please notify their teacher of the day(s) they will be attending ASEP class(es) and will not be taking the bus.
- ▶ If there are insufficient sign-ups for a class, the class will be cancelled and payment returned by the instructor.

PTA SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Glenview PTA offers **partial (50%) scholarships** for all classes to qualified applicants on a first-come, first-serve basis. The Application can be found in this packet OR you can pick up a copy from the Glenview at Santa Fe School Office. Please read the PTA Scholarship Application & Donation Form carefully. To qualify and register for a class, return completed scholarship request form with partial payment indicated (*50% tuition, checks payable to: Glenview PTA*) to the general PTA mailbox in the main office (not the white locked box). **Be sure to indicate on the form which class, time, and day you are interested in.** You will be contacted with the status of your scholarship request before the first day of the class in which you want to enroll.

A limited number of full Scholarships may be available upon special request. Qualifications still apply. *You must submit the completed PTA Scholarship Application Form to be considered.* Approved applicants will be notified by email/phone.

PTA Scholarship Application opens on MONDAY, JAN 10TH AND ENDS ON THUR, JAN 20TH. Send your completed Application form along with payment ASAP!

 Full scholarship — No payment is needed (note, there are very limited full scholarships).
