March 14 Day of Action

As educators and parents, the recent events at Marjory Stoneman Douglas School have been scary and upsetting. It is a sad reminder that we must all continue to speak out to change policies that can allow such violence to happen in some of the most sacred places in our communities.

Many community members have asked about the March 14th Walk out-March for Gun Safety organized in response to recent violent incidents on schools. Glenview staff will not be organizing a school walk out on March 14th, however teachers have met in grade levels to determine what will be appropriate activities for students to do to honor this movement. For younger students, this may include talking about anti-bullying activities that focus on how we keep each other safe and care for each other by using our tools and our Restorative Justice practices. For upper grades this may be continued discussions around social movements, similar to what our teachers have started last week regarding union organizing, or writing persuasive opinion letters to congresspeople about gun control. I encourage you to contact your child's teacher if you have questions or concerns about what will be done in your child's class that day.
