

## General Busing Information

### 1) Communication Regarding Your Child's Regular Bus Schedule

Please fill out the attached Weekly Glenview Student Bus Riding Schedule, indicating which days and times your child will ride the bus. There is an area to note if your child will be attending an afterschool program on campus or will be picked up by an alternate off-campus program. Please give this schedule to your child's teacher.

### 2) Schedule Changes

Notify your child's teacher of any changes to this schedule as they arise. If your child took the bus to Santa Fe in the morning, but you plan to pick them up in the afternoon from Santa Fe, and do not want them to take the bus BACK to Brewer, please notify your child's teacher in advance.

### 3) ID Cards and Bus App

The GPS app used to track the buses' movement will not be ready for a few weeks. As it is a newly piloted program, the company contracting with Michael's Transportation is still working out the glitches. Consequently, we will not be using the student bus passes during the first month of school (at least). During this time, we will manually track the numbers of children boarding and unboarding to ensure that all children are off the bus. Look for updates in the weekly Glenview Grapevine regarding when the app and bus passes will be launched.

### 4) Volunteering

Parents are welcome to volunteer to assist in the morning and/or afternoon loading and unloading of students on and off buses at Edna Brewer Middle School. If interested, please see a bus supervisor for direction and to get a green vest. **Please note: non-OUSD staff is not allowed to ride the bus.**
