ONLINE ENROLLMENT

All courses now have online enrollment - please see course descriptions in this packet. How to book classes:

- 1 Visit <https://www.joinhomerom.com/sites/glenview-elementary-oakland>
- 2 While viewing classes, you can filter by grade or day of the week at the top.
- 3 To learn more about a program, click "See Details" which will provide you with more information on the course and the company leading it.
- 4 When you're ready to book, click "add" and you'll notice the course turn teal and a number pop up in your cart (upper right hand corner).
- 5 Note: You can add all your classes and students at once and will be asked to assign classes to specific students once you checkout.

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- 6 Once you're done selecting classes, click your cart button (upper right hand corner) and you'll be prompted to review your selections.
- 7 Next, you can either create an account or login if you have already done so.
- 8 Once you're logged in, you'll then assign students to each class as well as their dismissal for that day.
- 9 Once all information has been added, you'll finalize your purchase by adding in your credit card (note: if you are a scholarship student, you will be sent an email with enrollment instructions).
- 10 Lastly, once all classes have been booked, you'll be able to see the course details in your Homeroom account and you'll also receive an automatic email confirmation.
- 11 If you ever have any questions or need to support, feel free to use the chat box in the lower right hand corner on the site.
- 12 ONLY scholarship applicants should submit registration forms to the PTA Mailbox in the main office. Please see the Scholarship Information and Scholarship Application in this packet.

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PARENT GUIDELINES

- ▶ **Please make sure your child knows the time and place of his/her enrichment class. It is important that students be on their best behavior and are instructed to go directly to the class after school.** STUDENTS MAY NOT WAIT IN THE OFFICE for classes to begin or for parent/guardian pick-up. Children with behavior problems to, from and during class may not be allowed to continue attending classes in the program.
- ▶ **The school requires that course providers escort TK and K students from their regular classroom to the ASEP location on the school campus.** Parents/guardians will pickup their students at the assigned ASEP location after class. If your student attends Adventure Time (AT) or Learning Spot (LS), please refer to their check-in procedures.
- ▶ **Please be on time to pick up your student!** There is no supervision provided after ASEP class dismissal. Neither the school nor the PTA is responsible for your children's whereabouts during this time. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure that the student is either enrolled in AT/LS, or supervised by an adult while on school premises. See individual class flyers/websites for late pick-up policies/ fines.
- ▶ Please take note of "no-class dates". Classes do not meet on school holidays. There may be other times when a class does not meet for other reasons. Please read course descriptions and flyers carefully for information on specific classes, and contact the class instructor/provider directly with questions.
- ▶ If your student normally takes the bus, be sure they and their teachers know their ASEP schedule, class location and to go directly to their ASEP class after school is dismissed. Please notify their teacher of the day(s) they will be attending ASEP class(es) and will not be taking the bus.
- ▶ If there are insufficient sign-ups for a class, the class will be cancelled and payment returned by the instructor.

A limited number of full Scholarships may be available upon request. Qualifications still apply. You must submit the completed PTA Scholarship Application Form to be considered. Approved applicants will be notified by email/phone.

Please read the PTA Scholarship Application & Donation Form carefully. To qualify and register for a class, return completed scholarship request form with partial payment indicated (50% tuition, checks payable to: Glenview PTA)

to the general PTA mailbox in the main office or email ruthlabrie@comcast.net.

Be sure to indicate on the form which class, time, and day you are interested in. You will be contacted with the status of your scholarship request before the first day of the class in which you want to enroll. Please help us expedite your requests by submitting the application form early. Once your scholarship is approved you will receive an email with enrollment instructions. You must complete within 2 days of receiving. This includes 100% covered and partial scholarships. **PTA Scholarship Application opens on Friday, January 18th and ends on Friday, January 25th. Send your completed Application form along with payment ASAP!**
