Konstella Korner: Pro Tips

– If you're on the app, you can set different notification settings for each room/group you're in. For example, you can have your classroom send an immediate notification when a message is posted, but have a different setting for the Strike Questions social. When in a room, click the icon in the top right, select Members and Settings, and choose on or off with the slider.

– When you're viewing your Feed, you can view just announcements or just sign-ups. Click More and then an option.

– You can create an announcement or sign-up for any room or group you are a member of. Click Create to check it out.

– All parents can create social groups. Right now we have General Glenview Forum, Strike Questions, and more. Browse the social groups to check them out.

Valentine's Day Guidelines: Valentine's Day can be so fun for school aged children. I remember fondly looking at the different little cards I would get from my classmates, and how good it felt to hand them out. Handing out cards is optional, of course, but if your child brings cards, please make sure there is enough for everyone in class. Also please remember that candy and sweets are not allowed in school. Kids have so many opportunities to eat junk food; we want school to be a healthy environment. Thank you for finding healthy alternatives. To further support making being healthy fun, we will have our first annual "Walk for Your Heart." Kids will walk as many laps as they can around the field and get a card stamped for each lap. Each grade level has a different time slot -- ask your child's teacher or check the Glenview website for the schedule.

Snacks at school: Morning recess is at 10:15. At this time of day many kids are hungry. With a change in Food Services policy about taking fruit out of the cafeteria, we have been able to hand out the fruit not eaten at breakfast to provide snack for some students who do not have the means to bring a snack to school. We obviously do not screen the students when they come into the office about whether or not they are food insecure. Unfortunately, there are more students who want snack than snack to provide, so we have started to hold it back for kids that we know really need it. Please know we will always try to feed hungry children no matter their circumstances, but also make sure to send a snack with your child if you can. It might help to have a conversation with your child at home about need. Thank you so much.
