The SBAC assessments are computer-based tests that measure students' knowledge of California's English language arts (ELA) and mathematics Common Core Standards. Please make sure your child gets plenty of rest, attends every day of their testing week and that they show up on time!

Welcome back! I hope everyone had a relaxing and fun Spring Break. State Testing (SBAC) is fast approaching. I wanted to let parents know that you are able to access a practice test online if you are curious about what kinds of things are tested, and the platform that students use to take the test. Go to caaspp.org/practice-and-training/ and click on "Students interface and practice testing." Sign-in as a guest user. These tests are only one measure of your child's progress and while Glenview's "State report card" is partially informed by our students' scores, we use much more immediate and formative assessments to guide our instruction here at school. I find the biggest challenge for kids can be that taking this test can be really boring, which puts us into an area where Social Emotional Learning comes into play-- it is surely a life skill to be bored and yet manage those feelings to do your best! I encourage you to check the practice-test out with your child and work with them on managing boredom.
