SBAC Testing

The annual administration of the Smarter Balanced Assessments Consortium (SBAC) assessments for all third through fifth grade students begins April 15th. The SBAC assessments are computer-based tests that measure students' knowledge of California's English language arts (ELA) and mathematics Common Core Standards. Please make sure your child gets plenty of rest, attends every day of their testing week and that they show up on time! Our first week will be 3rd graders - April 15th - 19th!

Adventure Time - Fall 2019

Adventure Time is preparing for Fall 2019 registration. Enrollment Application forms will be mailed on Friday April 26, 2019. Every child who is a student at Glenview Elementary School will be mailed an application form.

Please bring your completed application with the \$85.00 application fee to the Adventure Time portable between 7:00-9:00 a.m. and 2:00-6:00 p.m. Applications will be accepted for after school care until 6:00 p.m., Friday May 3, 2019. Applications for before school care will be accepted ongoing.

Space in the program for after school care will be accepted in the following order by a lottery system:

1. Currently enrolled Adventure Time students;
2. Siblings of currently enrolled students;
3. Allotted spaces for incoming kindergartners;
4. A lottery for the remaining spaces.
