Principal Quinn's Corner

You may have heard your child talk about "the toolbox." Toolbox is our Social Emotional Learning curriculum. It supports children to understand and manage their own emotional, social, and academic success.

The "tools" are a metaphor for innate capacities that humans have that help us navigate the world and our interactions. The first 4 tools are the focus of the beginning of the year and are taught in developmentally appropriate ways.

They are the Breathing Tool: I calm myself and check in, the Quiet/Safe Place tool: I remember my quiet/safe place, the Empathy tool: I care for myself. I care for others, and the Personal Space Tool: I have a right to my space and so do you. There are 12 tools in all, and our focus is not just explicitly teaching them, but looking for how these capacities show up and help us in all aspects of our school day, from play to academics.

Ask your children about the tools and how they use them throughout their days.
