## Principal Quinn's Corner

At our first SSC meeting last week we welcomed new members and conducted what is called the "establishment meeting." School Site Council guidelines are governed by the Greene Act and there are some specific tasks we need to accomplish at our first meeting. We reviewed the SSC by-laws, elected members to leadership positions (chairperson, vice-chairperson, secretary and parliamentarian). We then reviewed our Strategic Site Plan for Achievement (SPSA) and the budget that was developed last year for this year. We had one significant change to our budget which is that we lost Title 1 funds because the percentage of students identified as low income dropped to 27.2%. Our percentage is based on last year's enrollment. The committee was very engaged and had a lot of great questions for me. The SSC meetings are open to everyone, though only the members may vote.
