On Friday, teachers will be reviewing student work (K-2 will be looking at student writing and 3rd-5th will be scoring and analyzing SBAC interim "Literary Text" assessment data). K-2 teachers will also go to a half day refresher training on the SIPPS curriculum (Systematic Instruction in Phonological Awareness, Phonics, and Sight Words).
