Principal Quinn's Corner

At our final School Site Council (SSC) meeting this week, we reviewed our school wide goals and approved our Site Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA). Our 4 goals are: 1) to reduce the percentage of chronic absenteeism (chronic absenteeism is missing 10% of school for any reason, excused or unexcused), 2 & 3) to reduce the achievement gap in Math & Language Arts, as measured by our State tests in 3rd-5th grade, SBAC, by 15 points over 3 years, and 4) to maintain a reclassification rate for our English Learners (Reclassification is the terminology for when a student who is considered an English Learner has met the criteria to become "reclassified" as Fully English Proficient). If you are interested in the nitty gritty of how public schools are funded and how our budget is aligned to our goals, consider running for SSC next year; there are 2 parent positions open. I am grateful to our parents who were on it this year: Maureen Whalen, Jessica Coulson, Brian Perkins, Daniel Ettlinger, and Amanda Staab.
