There was discussion about whether that space is optimal for that purpose.

Drill - Oct. 17: Glenview will join the entire OUSD school district and people from around California to practice how to Drop, Cover, and Hold On at 10:17 a.m. on October 17 during the Great ShakeOut Earthquake Drills, which began in California in 2008.

Participating is a great way for your family or organization to be prepared to survive and recover quickly from big earthquakes. Your child may come home that week asking you about your family plan for earthquakes. Parents are encouraged to communicate with their children their family plan.
