Halloween Parade

Wednesday, Oct. 31st 1:30

Glenview's Halloween Parade is on Wednesday, Oct. 31st. Students will parade up and down 54th St and around the playground with their class, and we welcome families to line the sidewalks and wave and cheer for the kids. Classes will assemble in their morning meeting spot to start the parade at 1:30.

Important costume reminders:

- Students in grades 1-5 are not permitted to wear their costume to school. Rather, they can bring a costume and change at school before the parade.
- TK-K students are permitted to wear their costume to school.
- No full-face masks should be worn during the parade.
- Students are not allowed to bring any costume accessories to school that could be perceived as scary for our younger students or unsafe, this includes: horror character costumes, full face masks, swords, knives, guns, fake blood. If they do so, the item or costume will be held by the teacher for the parent to pick up.

Principal Quinn's Corner

Part of our Social Emotional Learning curriculum is "buddy classes." Each class is matched up with a class in a different grade level and they meet at least once a month, on the last Friday, to do activities that build community. The teachers collaborate to design activities that would be beneficial to both classes, focused on building empathy and connection across the school. Last year, we even had some buddy classes attend assemblies together, rather than the traditional way of kids sitting with their homerooms.
