I finally got our school budget for next year. In addition to losing our Title 1 status, and the funding attached to that (~\$40,000), we were cut by \$36,000. I have been meeting with teachers, the SSC, and PTA in the past few months so that I have input on the priorities in our program. Our budget needs to align to our site goals around improving outcomes for all of our students. Making cuts is horrible, especially when we know our kids (and staff) deserve so much more. My goal is to develop a budget that maintains structures we have in place that benefit all kids, and that we can rebuild when funding is increased. I'm forever an optimist on this. It is in times like this that our resolve is tested, and what I can say with certainty is that we will work together to make the best of what we have.
