PROJECT DESCRIPTION

A new modern classroom building will be constructed at Glenview Elementary. The new building will replace the current classroom building and relocatables. The new classroom building will feature:

Existing main entry and accompanying façade, yard in front of main entry will be repaved. New handicap accessible (ADA) stair lift by stairs will provide accessibility from street level to the main entry doorway. Replacement of 21 classrooms, library, cafeteria, multipurpose room, stage and administrative offices.

- Basement rough-in work was completed.
- Interior west framing and rough-in work continued.
- Interior east rough-in was substantially completed.
- East courtyard site work continued.
