ABOUT THE READ-A-THON

What is it?

The Read-a-Thon is Glenview Elementary's annual spring fundraiser. It has two goals: Get students reading and raise \$115,000 for essential academic programs and enrichment at Glenview.

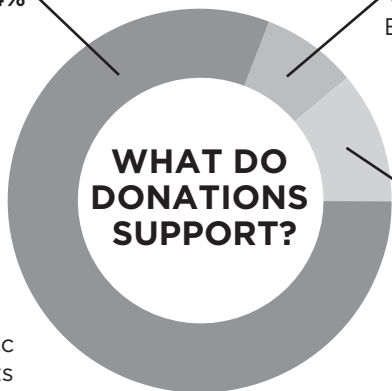

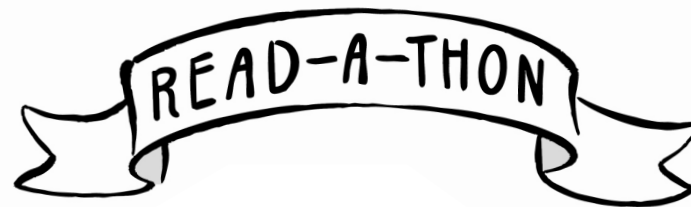

How to log minutes
